Kelco Cabinets notes that these figures are directional estimates for mid-range and premium custom builds. Actual pricing depends on material, finish, and cabinet box construction, and any cabinet door style cost comparison will shift with those variables.

"Homeowners often walk in believing one style is always the cheaper option, and the truth is more nuanced than that," said Preston Kelsch, owner of Kelco Cabinets. "Understanding the cost of shaker vs flat panel cabinets before committing to a door style helps people budget realistically and avoid surprises later in the project. The style itself matters less than where a homeowner is shopping on the price spectrum."

The data arrives as shaker remains one of the most requested cabinet styles heading into 2026, valued for its versatility across traditional, transitional, and modern farmhouse kitchens. Flat-panel, sometimes called slab, continues to gain interest among homeowners pursuing a modern or minimalist look with clean, uninterrupted door surfaces.

Beyond cost, the two styles differ in maintenance and appearance. Shaker doors, with a recessed center panel and framed border, offer a classic look that suits most home styles. Flat-panel doors present a single smooth surface that reads as more contemporary.
